At Rise: *The curtain opens on the little pigs “Whistling While They Work”*

Narrator: Once there were three little pigs that lived together in mutual respect and harmony with their environment. Using materials that were indigenous to the area, they each built a beautiful house.

One pig built a house of straw

One pig built a house of sticks and..

One a house of dung, clay, and creeper vines shaped into bricks and baked in a small kiln.

Pig 1: I can’t believe it!

Pig 2: We are all done with our house

Pig 3: We can all take satisfaction in our hard work and self-determination in successfully constructing our homes in a mutually respectful manner.

Narrator: The pigs lived peacefully, until one day...

(Big Bad Wolf Music as the Wolf comes on stage)

Narrator: There came along a big, bad, wolf with expansionist ideas. He saw the pigs and grew very hungry, in both a physical and ideological sense. When the pigs saw the wolf, they ran into the house of straw.
Wolf chases pigs.

Wolf: *(In a booming voice)* Little pigs, little pigs. Let me in!

Pigs 1, 2, 3: *(Looking to each other, then join hands in a show of strength)*
Your gunboat tactics hold no fear for pigs defending their homes and culture!

Narrator: The wolf wasn't to be denied what he thought was his manifest destiny. So he huffed, and he puffed, and blew down the house of straw.

Pigs: Run!

Narrator: Where the house of straw stood, other wolves bought up the land and started a banana plantation.

Music "Day Oh", The Banana plantation replaces house.

Banana Plantation: I am the symbol of hard working society that is PILLAGED.

Pigs and wolf race to the house of sticks

Wolf: Little pigs, little pigs, let me in!

Pigs: Go to HADES, you carnivorous, imperialistic oppressor.

Wolf: *(chuckles at their naivety)*
They are so childlike in their little ways.

It will be a shame to see them go, but progress cannot be stopped.

Narrator: So the wolf huffed, and puffed, and blew down the house of sticks.

Pigs: We will triumph in the end!

(Pigs run to house of stone. The Wolf follows in tow.)

Narrator: Where the house of sticks stood, other wolves built a time-share condo resort complex for vacationing wolves, with each unit a fiberglass reconstruction OF THE HOUSE OF STICKS – the irony was not lost on the little pigs... as well as curio shops, snorkeling, and dolphin shows.

Time Share/Condo: I am the symbol of hard working society that is MUTATED and TWISTED for the recreational façade of the rich and entitled.

(Music Plays Calypso style... The Condo replaces house of sticks. The pigs wail in sadness and grief from the new house – the wailing gives into quaking in fear.)

Wolf: Little pigs, little pigs, let me in!

(“So You Hear the People Sing” from Les Mis soars. Pigs are become empowered and start singing. A Flag with a Pig is flying back and forth.)

Narrator: The pigs organized a rebellion to having their civil and constitutional rights violated.

Pig #1: We demand UN intervention!

Pig #2: Write your congress-persons letters of protest!

Pig #3: Little pigs CAN make a difference!

Narrator: By now the wolf was getting angry at the pigs’ refusal to see the situation from the carnivore’s point of view. So he huffed and puffed, and huffed and puffed, then...

(Wolf grabs chest. Falls down dead.)

Narrator: Suffered a massive heart attack brought on from eating too many fatty foods.

(Pigs cheering and dancing. Other pigs/animals come on stage. Mime out actions below)

Narrator: After much rejoicing, the three little pigs and other empowered animals joined together to liberate their homeland.

This brigade of porcinistas (por-sin-EES-tas) attacked the resort complex, sending a clear signal to the rest of the hemisphere not to meddle in their internal affairs.

Then the pigs set up a model socialist democracy with free education, universal healthcare, and affordable housing for everyone. *(After applause, take a beat).*

Narrator: Before we continue with our show, please note that the wolf in this story was a metaphorical construct. No actual wolves were harmed in the making of this production.
